Men, come join us on Wednesdays at 8:30am at the City Limits Restaurant (next to McDonalds).

This is going to be a different kind of men's group article. I had to opportunity to attend one of the women's groups for lunch. Right away I noticed the difference between the "groups." Both groups talk before the food comes, but when the men get their food, they stop talking (mostly) and eat! When the women got their food, the talking continued. I was so fascinated with this that I pulled up some info on the differences between men and women:

- 1. Women tend to talk more about people men tend to talk more about things and their surrounding.
- When a woman nods, she is trying to show she is listening and wants the speaker to continue. When a man nods, he is showing agreement with the speaker.
- 3. Women tend to use touch for camaraderie Men use touch for signals of power.
- 4. Women are trained from a young age to give a lot of nonverbal encouragement—whether they agree with what is being said or not.Like nodding, tilting the head, saying yes, etc. However, men don't think it's as necessary. This can come across to women as cold or unemotional.
- 5. Women use 5 speaking tones when talking. And as they get emotional or under stress, the voice rises making them squeaky or high pitched. Men only use 3 speaking tones when talking and show little emotion.
- 6. Our faces can demonstrate over 10,000 facial expressions. However, women and men use these differently. Overall, men demonstrate less facial expressiveness than women. Men also smile less than women. This is because women have been taught more appeasement body language as children and are encouraged to always get along with others and cooperate. The smile is the body language sign of appeasement.
